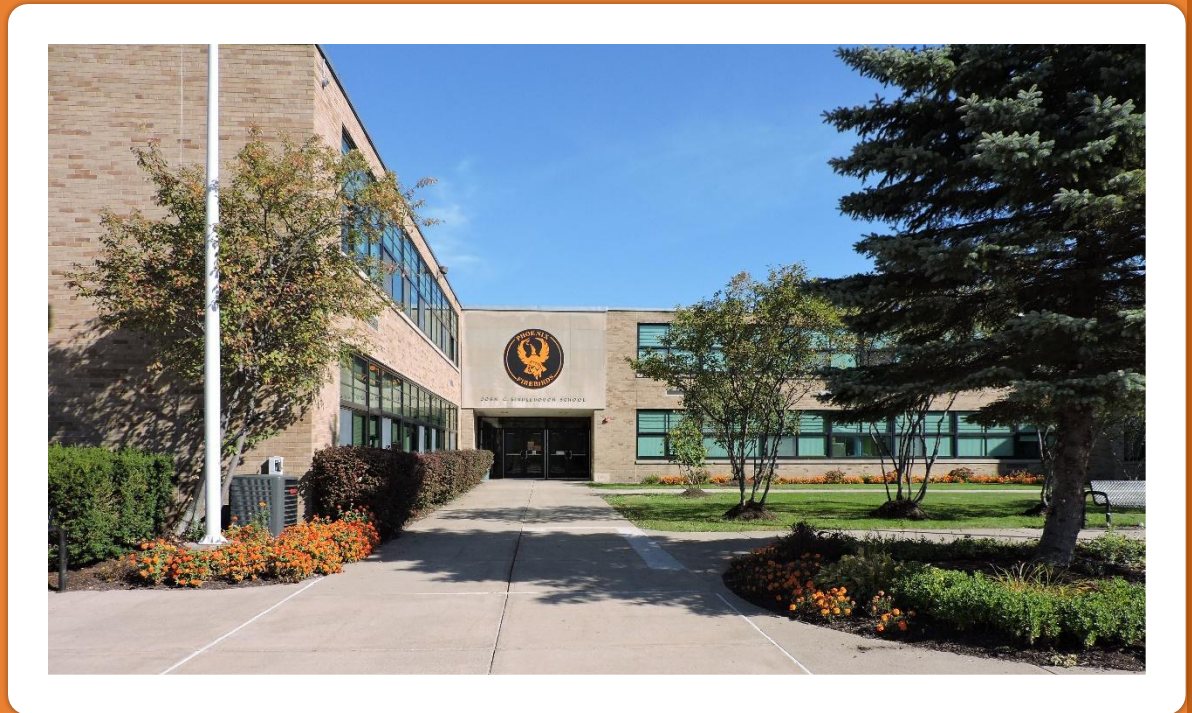

Transition - EJD to JCB

EJD

1. Hybrid Schedule of periods
2. Promotion to next grade
3. Minimum 50 grading
4. No cell phone policy
5. Single grade level classes
6. Lab minutes not required

JCB

1. Four 80-minute blocks per day
2. Must earn credit to move on
3. Min. of 50 Marking Period 1 only
4. Cell phone - limited use
5. Some mixed grade levels
6. 1200 minutes required for exam

Scheduling Process

EJD - counselors meet with 8th grade students and families (February).

JCB - students meet with their counselor during a study hall or class (February):

- Sophomores next
- Freshmen with Mrs. Ransiear

Response to Intervention - JCB

Tier 1 = Instruction for *All Students*

- differentiated, proactive, classrooms

Tier 2 = Interventions for *Some Students*

- targeted, study hall, small group, after school

Tier 3 = Intensive Interventions for *Individual Students*

- frequent, individual, scheduled courses
