What is the FAFSA?

It stands for Free Application for Federal Student Aid. We highly recommend you fill it out!

The FAFSA covers any federal aid you might qualify for. New York State also awards aid (TAP) and that application will be linked at the end of the FAFSA if you select a NYS college/university.



- ☐ Watch for Student Aid Report (SAR) & keep in touch with the financial aid offices at the schools you are applying to




Step 1: FSA ID

Step 2: Collect Information



All Income/Bank/Brokerage statements and W-2's must be from 2019!


You will need your Social Security Number (SSN) as well as your parents.

If you have a Driver's License, you will need that as well.


You must use the name on your birth certificate.

Step 3: Complete the FAFSA





You will be asked about ordering your schools. For New York State, the order in which you enter them does not matter.




If you are eligible to

use the IRS Data


If you utilize the IRS DRT, you will be redirected to the IRS website. Your FAFSA will save, and it will return once you have finished with the IRS.

If you are not using the IRS DRT, you will be directed to start filling out information on your parents financial information. This is where you will need papers such as W-2's and tax returns.






The FSA ID that you created will allow you to electronically sign the FAFSA

If so, you can transfer your parents' information into a new FAFSA for your brother or sister to save time. Your parents will have to provide a signature again, but thei's all.



FAQ/Resources

- Can I Receive federal student aid if I am homeless or at risk of being homeless?
 - Yes when asked whether you are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless and "unaccompanied" (meaning not with your parents), answer yes and continue with the application

- I filled out my FAFSA! When can I expect to receive information about my financial aid?
 - You have to apply and be accepted by the college first. Once you are accepted, the college will
 put your financial aid award letter together
 - The timing will vary on how long it will take for them to get you your letter, reach out to the financial aid offices at the colleges you applied to!
