Developments since Early April

- Legislature passes budget with a \$1.53 Billion increase in foundation aid
- \$2 Billion increase in overall education funding
- Rejected the database freeze based on Executive Budget
- Rejected the \$250K for capital outlay projects
- Full phase in of foundation aid over two years
- Expanded UPK funding for several districts, \$250 Million over 2 years
- Rejected increasing the BOCES threshold from \$30k salary
- Tax rebate in fall of 2022 based on income
- All buses purchased starting 2027-> Electric. Whole Fleet-> 2035



What does this mean for Phoenix?

- 3% increase in Foundation Aid
- Expense driven aids
- Same amount of aid as Executive Budget
- New UPK funds, additional 25 slots (?) hardly filling now ⊗
- Still in the prior adjustment queue
- Closed the budget gap and allowed for additions to budget
- Tax levy increase of \$174,000 or 1%

Proposed Additions

- Added H.S. Social Studies position
- Middle School Reading in leu of 2 TA's
- \$30k increase in SRO service with Village
- Special Education at MAM ICT
- \$200k for fuel and utility contingencies



Federal Funds

- Phoenix received \$1,679,413 & \$4,504,085 in federal stimulus funds=**\$6,183498**
- Must be used a separate fund and not the general fund
- To be liquidated over the 21-22,22-23,23-24 school years
- 20% to be used for resource & learning loss program
- Summer enrichment camps, summer school, after school enrichment
