Feb 2023 First draft (roll forward + additions) budget presented to Board of Education. \Box initial \$427,000 budget gap

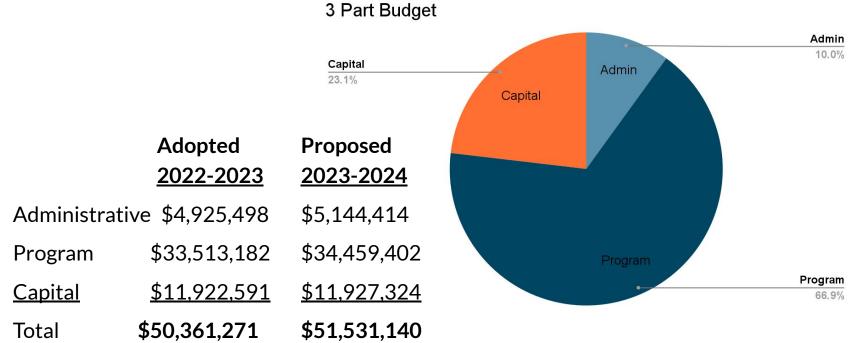
March 2023 District develops strategies to fill gap

NYS Legislature passes late budget that provides \$2 Billion aid increase to schools. Phoenix CSD closes budget gap.

April 2023 Board of Education adopts the 2023-2024 budget.

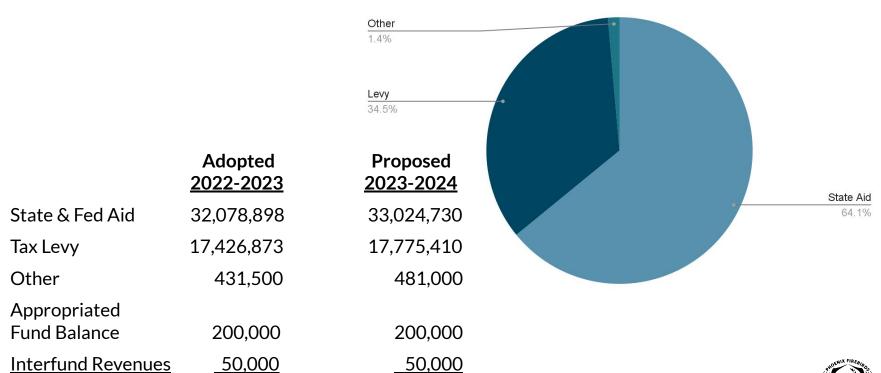

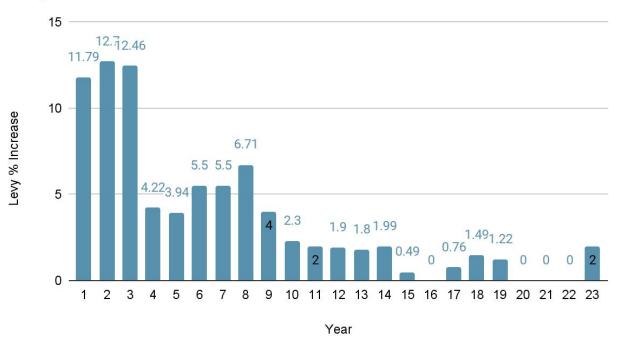

Budget Facts

- The 2023-2024 proposed budget increase is \$1,169,869 or 2.32%
- District closed a \$427k budget gap
- Budget maintains all academic, co-curricular, and athletic programs
- The 2023-2024 proposed budget tax levy increase is \$348,537
- Is below the tax cap of 5.21% or \$908,558
- Added M.S Math Teacher, Full day UPK
- Free meals for all Phoenix K-12 students!



Propositions

Budget Adoption \$51,531,140

"BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed budget of expenditures of the Phoenix Central School District for the school year 2023-2024 in the amount of \$51,531,140 and for the purposes shown in the statement of estimated expenditures adopted by the Board of Education, be and the same hereby is approved and the amount thereof, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by a levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the school district, after first deducting the monies available from State Aid and other sources as provided by law."

Purchase of Buses, \$507,311

- Replace 3-66 passenger buses – 90% aided by NYS
